

Bryan G. Argo Memorial Scholarship

History majors who are residents of Niagara or Erie county and full-time students who are working at least part-time and have compiled an overall grade point average of at least 3.0 are eligible for the Bryan G. Argo Memorial Scholarship. Applicants submit a letter of reference from a current professor or civic or spiritual leader and write a personal statement as described in the application. The scholarship awards demonstrated family values, integrity, and personal achievements. This award is made each year through the generosity of the family and friends of Bryan Argo, a History student who was devoted to family and friends, believed strongly in continuing education, and whose promising life was tragically cut short. The scholarship is awarded in the fall to be used during that current academic year.

For the Bryan G. Argo Scholarship the following is required:

1. Personal Statement: Attach a typewritten statement that demonstrates your interest in the study of history. Issues to address may include: the basis for your interest in history, academic and non-academic activities which demonstrate your commitment to history and the larger community, and your future career plans. Also describe your personal characteristics and values that make you suited for the Argo award. Statements should be 1-3 double-spaced, typewritten pages.
